Dear academician,

Please be informed on the process of registering the above matters.

<u>Scopus ID</u> is generated automatically for the researcher upon their publication indexed by Scopus.

The Scopus Author Identifier assigns a unique number to groups of documents written by the same author via an algorithm that matches authorship based on a certain criteria. If a document cannot be confidently matched with an author identifier, it is grouped separately. In this case, you may see more than 1 entry for the same author.

User with several author ID can request to merge profiles regardless of the name used. The process as follows:

1. Search for the profile that has the preffered name

2. On the profile page, on the right hand side of the screen select " Request author Detail Corrections"

3. The author Profile Wizard will open and provide instructions

4. As step 3 of the Wizard is "Review Documents' and at the bottom is the link " search for missing documents". This function allows you to search and add the papers which is not in the profile.
5. If you have trouble, you can write directly to <u>authorfeedback@scopus.com</u> and ask if they can merge the two profiles.
